1. <u>The Closing of the Holy Doors at St Mary's Inverness</u> will be at the 6.30 pm Mass on Sunday 13 November.

During this Mass there will be Prayers for Healing and Anointing with the BALM of MERCY- from the Shrine of the Divine Mercy at Krakow. YOU ARE ALL WELCOME

2. <u>The Ordination to the Priesthood of Deacon Andrew Niski</u> is at 3.00 pm on Fri 6 Jan 17. The ordination will be at here at St Mary's. Every parish in the deanery is likely to be represented by priests and people, and there will be guests from other parts of the Diocese, and from further afield. It would be helpful for planning purposes to have an idea of likely numbers, even at this stage. Please would you sign –up on the lists provided at the west end of the Church.

<u>Wed 7 Dec at 7.30 pm :</u> In the Presbytery : Faith Sharing – "Go tell!" Further reflections on Evangelisation – a discussion.

<u>Fri 16 Dec at 7.30 pm</u> : in the Marian Room : Readings, Reflection and Discussion of T.S.Eliot's "Little Gidding". The poem focuses on the unity of past, present, and future, and claims that understanding this unity is an indicator for salvation. It may be helpful for reflection and prayer in Advent. It is a most prayerful and beautiful poem.

4. <u>The Seminarians' Appeal</u>- a reminder that a new Mandatory Collection is to be taken every year on the Solemnity of Christ the King, beginning on Sun 20 Nov. Updated Appeal leaflets will be forthcoming from the Diocesan office.

The cost of Seminarians' fees and accommodation has risen.
