**Remembrance Sunday:**

The Centenary of the Armistice which ended the First World War is being commemorated throughout the United Kingdom. The bell at St Mary's (in the Convent) is to be tolled for **TWO minutes at 1230 today**. This is to comply with a nation-wide request by Her Majesty's Government to mark the end of the First World War- the time and the day one hundred years ago. At the beginning of the Mass we will lay our customary wreathes at our own Parish War Memorial in the War Memorial Window bay. The Second Collection at all Masses of this Sunday will be to support the work of Help for Heroes.
