St Mother Teresa of Calcutta (1910-1997)



St Teresa of Calcutta

Teresa left home to join the Sisters of Loreto in Rathfarnham, Ireland, from there she went to the Sisters of Loreto in India arriving there in 1929.

Although Teresa enjoyed teaching at the school, of which she became Headmistress, she was increasingly disturbed by the poverty surrounding her in Calcutta. On 10 September 1946, she experienced "the call within the call" "I was to leave the convent and help the poor while living among them. It was an order. To fail would have been to break the faith."

She began missionary work with the poor in 1948, replacing her traditional Loreto habit with a simple, white cotton sari with a blue border. At the beginning of 1949 Teresa was joined in her effort by a group of young women, and she laid the foundation for a new religious community helping the "poorest among".

On 7 October 1950, Teresa received Vatican permission for the diocesan congregation, which would become the Missionaries of Charity. In her words, it would care for "the hungry, the naked, the homeless, the crippled, the blind, the lepers, all those people who feel unwanted, unloved, uncared for throughout society, people that have become a burden to the society and are shunned by everyone"

Teresa said, "A beautiful deathis for people who lived like animals to die like angels—loved and wanted.".

A Prayer of St Teresa of Calcutta:

Give us a heart as beautiful, pure, and spotless as yours. A heart like yours, so full of love and humility. May we be able to receive Jesus as the Bread of Life, to love Him as you loved Him, to serve Him under the mistreated face of the poor. We ask this through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.
