St Mary's, Inverness: Novena to the Sacred Heart of Jesus: Day ONE.





Reflection: The beloved Apostle, St John the Evangelist was close to the Heart of Jesus and is thus the Patron of this devotion. During the Last Supper he leaned his head upon the bosom of Jesus. His gesture of reclining upon Jesus' breast expressed faithful trust and brotherly confidence, a familiarity between Disciple and Master. He was at the foot of the Cross and received from Jesus Himself the role as a son to be Protector of the Virgin Mary (Jn 19:26-27), and Mary was given the Motherhood of the Apostolic Church in the person of the Apostle John.

'Now there was leaning on Jesus' bosom one of his disciples, whom Jesus loved'. [Douai Rheims]

Before beginning our Novena Prayers we imagine what this was like for St John, being as it were, 'heart to heart' with Jesus. We see loving familiarity in which there is reciprocity of understanding.
