St Mary's, Inverness: Novena to the Sacred Heart of Jesus: Day TWO





Reflection: St Luke 23.34 & 43 **Forgiveness** Jesus often spoke about forgiveness and he used parables to teach about it, and the greatest forgiveness parable of all is the Prodigal Son (Lk 15:11-32). As Jesus hung on the Cross he told the repentant criminal, "Today you will be with me in paradise" (Lk 23:43) and he prayed for his executioners, "Father, forgive them, they do not know what they are doing." (Lk 23:34). Before we begin our Novena prayers we consider in our minds and hearts what it would be like to have been there as Jesus taught about forgiveness, and how His Divine Compassion forgave others in their ignorance and cruelty.



Prayer: Lord Jesus your love transforms evil by goodness. Help us, Lord, weak as we are, to unite our efforts to yours, so that so we can enhance good and bring peace and joy to others.
