The Novena to the Sacred Heart of Jesus Day SIX

The Wounded Heart: "One of the soldiers opened His side with a spear" (cf.Jn19:31-37) This Wound is a door. St Augustine comments on this when he writes – "The Evangelist says, 'opened', to show us that the door of life was thrown open, through which the Sacraments of the Church flow forth". These Sacraments are represented by the Blood and Water which flow from the wounded Heart. It is in this wounded Heart that we find the "unsearchable riches" of which St Paul speaks in his Letter to the Church in Ephesus (cf.Eph.3:8-19).

"From all My Wounds, like from streams, mercy flows for souls. But the Wound in My Heart is the Fountain of unfathomable mercy. From this Fountain spring all graces for souls." (Diary of St Faustina, para.1190) Divine Mercy: The Healing Love of Jesus

If we are wounded and healed, we pray for those who are in need of healing: the abused, the addicted, all victims of abortion, the desolate, those held captive, those deprived of dignity by the indifference of others, and those whose lives are blighted by racism.

Jesus, He meets us where we are Jesus, He heals our secret scars

Jesus, in the Sacraments, He cleans, cherishes and nourishes us. We bring to the Sacred Heart of Jesus the wounds of a wounded world.

Jesus, give us Your Heart! Make us strong to love!
