The Beuronese school of artistic expression is a movement of the modern era attempting to make a continuous connection between beauty, truth and the necessary role of these in liturgy and prayer. Here we see a Beuronese nativity painted by the Monks of Conception Abbey in Missouri.

Saint Joseph, depicted with the staff and the lily, kneels in humble adoration. He is the mirror image of the Virgin and like her he worships in purity and faith. Above him are the angels bearing the message,

'Gloria in excelsis Deo'.

Stylized and idealized, this image speaks to our developed understanding of Joseph as a guardian with a profound and important role. Artistically akin to the earliest icons, these much more recent depictions see Saint Joseph as a fatherly figure, intercessor, and protector of the Church.

The Year of St Joseph: Patron of the Church



Pope Francis announced a Year of St. Joseph Tuesday in honour of the one hundred and fiftieth anniversary of the proclamation of St Joseph as patron of the Universal Church.

The year began on The Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception on 8 Dec 2020, and it will conclude on 8 Dec 2021, according to a decree authorized by the Pope. The decree said that Pope Francis had established a Year of St. Joseph so

that "every member of the faithful, following his example, may strengthen their life of faith daily in the complete fulfilment of God's will."

In addition to the decree, Pope Francis issued an Apostolic Letter dedicated to the foster-father of Jesus.

This Letter is called *Patris corde* ("With a father's heart") and in it the Holy Father writes that he wanted to share some "personal reflections" on the spouse of the Blessed Virgin Mary.

"My desire to do so increased during these months of pandemic," he said, noting that many people had made hidden sacrifices during the crisis in order to protect others.

"Each of us can discover in Joseph -- the man who goes unnoticed, a daily, discreet and hidden presence -- an intercessor, a support and a guide in times of trouble,".

Pope Francis has promoted devotion to St. Joseph throughout his pontificate.

He began his Petrine ministry on 19 March, 2013, the Solemnity of St. Joseph, and dedicated the homily at his inauguration Mass to the saint.

"In the Gospels, St. Joseph appears as a strong and courageous man, a working man, yet in his heart we see great tenderness, which is not the virtue of the weak but rather a sign of strength of spirit and a capacity for concern, for compassion, for genuine openness to others, for love," he said.

On 1 May, 2013, the Feast of St Joseph the Worker, the Holy Father issued a decree instructing that the name of St. Joseph should be inserted into Eucharistic Prayers II, III, and IV.

During an Apostolic Visit to the Philippines in 2015, Pope Francis explained why he kept an image of the saint on his desk.

"I would also like to tell you something very personal,"... "I have great love for St. Joseph, because he is a man of silence and strength."

"On my table I have an image of St. Joseph sleeping. Even when he is asleep, he is taking care of the Church! Yes! We know that he can do that. So when I have a problem, a difficulty, I write a little note and I put it underneath St. Joseph, so that he can dream about it! In other words I tell him: pray for this problem!"

At his general audience on 18 March 20 when the Pandemic was sweeping through Europe, Pope Francis urged Catholics to turn to St. Joseph in times of adversity.

"In life, at work and within the family, through joys and sorrows, he always sought and loved the Lord, deserving the Scriptures' eulogy that described him as a just and wise man,"

"Always invoke him, especially in difficult times and entrust your life to this great saint."

The Pope concluded his new Apostolic Letter by urging Catholics to pray to St. Joseph for "the grace of graces: our conversion."

He ended the text with a prayer:

"Hail, Guardian of the Redeemer, Spouse of the Blessed Virgin Mary. To you God entrusted his only Son; in you Mary placed her trust; with you Christ became man. Blessed Joseph, to us too, show yourself a father, and guide us in the path of life. Obtain for us grace, mercy and courage, and defend us from every evil. Amen."
